

West Newbury Youth Soccer

The first day of the Fall 2008 season is scheduled for September 6, 2008.

U10 – MVP League

U-10 is for children entering 3rd and 4th grade in September 2008.

The MVP League consists of teams from Merrimac, Groveland, West Newbury and Newburyport. Games are played on Saturday's and there will be at least one practice per week. The objective of the MVP League is to provide a non-results based league in which all the teams are of equal strength, yet start to introduce a competitive game with rules and referee's.

West Newbury will enter boys and girls teams into the MVP League. The number of teams will depend on the number of players who register. Players are required to wear a uniform for games, consisting of a red West Newbury soccer jersey with black pinstripes, black shorts and black socks with red stripes. Shin guards are mandatory and cleats are recommended. Players can wear the same shirt they had in U8 if it still fits. If anyone requires a new jersey, see section below on jerseys. Games and practice schedules will be provided to each child prior to the start of the season.

U6 / U7 / U8 Leagues

U-6, U-7 and U-8 are for children entering kindergarten, 1st or 2nd grade in September 2008.

U-6, U-7 and U-8 play on Saturday mornings (U-8's may have a practice session during the week). The program consists of 15 - 30 minutes of instructional soccer in a social and fun atmosphere and 15 - 30 minutes of a scrimmage each week. The teams are co-ed and each team has between 7 and 10 players. The scrimmages are 4 x 4 with no goalies.

A West Newbury soccer t-shirt (with a team color) will be provided to all U-6, U-7 and U-8 players and is included in the \$35 registration fee. Shin guards are mandatory and cleats are recommended.

Jerseys

All kids entering the U-6, U-7 and U-8 programs will be provided with a West Newbury soccer t-shirt (as described above). Unfortunately, for children participating in the U-10 program, the red jerseys with black pinstripes utilized in years past have been discontinued and are no longer available from the supplier. However, we intend to

continue using this discontinued jersey until a switch is required to a new jersey. If a child in the U-10 program requires a red jersey with black pinstripes, please indicate this on the registration form and arrangements will be made to provide a used jersey free of charge (this is to prevent the entire U10 program from having to buy a new jersey).

Coach Development

Beginning this year, West Newbury Youth Soccer will be offering and implementing coaching clinics as well as the opportunity to obtain a license from Mass Youth Soccer for all parents who volunteer to coach (head coaches and assistants). The clinics and the license course are designed to provide ideas about how to organize practices, ideas on parent education, learning theory, and the demonstration of basic techniques. To get the most out of each course, participation in the practical, active sessions is strongly encouraged, but is not required. This activity is not physically rigorous, and lasts approximately one half of each course/clinic. All clinics/courses are provided at no cost to the participants.

Coaching Clinics – We have tentatively scheduled coaching clinics at the New England Soccer School located at the Amesbury Sports Park. Clinics have been scheduled for the 1st week following the Labor Day Holiday as detailed below:

U-6 / U-7 / U-8 Coaches – A clinic is scheduled on Tuesday, September 2nd from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 pm. All volunteer coaches are expected to attend.

U-10 Coaches - A clinic is scheduled on Wednesday, September 3rd from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 pm. All volunteer coaches are expected to attend.

Mass Youth Soccer “G” Course - This beginning course for coaches teaches about both coaching organization and theory. The intention of the G course is to help you to become a more resourceful and confident “activity leader”- to combine your enthusiasm and commitment to children with the basic theory and practical exercises that we will provide. The course will cover teaching and correcting dribbling, passing, and shooting technique as well as particular characteristics of U6 and U8 players.

This course is confirmed and Mass Youth Soccer will be providing this course on Saturday, September 6th from 1:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. at the Page School. Each participant will be provided with a Mass Youth Soccer G Manual and coaching program shirt. This is a great opportunity for parents who are interested in becoming coaches to learn the basics of the game and to assist with the development of the kid’s skills.

CORI Form – Any parent who would like to volunteer as a coach must submit a CORI form. Forms are available on the website, www.wnyl.org . We request you submit this form in addition to your child’s registration form due by June 1, 2008.
